Ukraine Heritage and Archaeology Workshop is a one-day event at the University of Oxford gathering archaeologists in the United Kingdom to present and discuss recent events in Ukrainian archaeology.

It has become apparent, with the attention this heritage has received since the outbreak of the full-scale war, that the importance and uniqueness of Ukrainian archaeology deserve a closer look.

At the same time, current cultural, political, and military turbulence around the world draw attention to Ukraine even stronger — as a hotspot, as a place where culture suffers horrendous losses, and above all — as a place with a rich and important history.

The workshop's purpose is to provide a meeting space for scholars working on Ukrainian archaeological heritage, to compare their perspectives, and to establish a collaborative framework to study and preserve Ukrainian heritage effectively.

Researchers will present their investigations into Ukrainian archaeology and cultural heritage and engage in discussion on what can be done to support the archaeological sciences in Ukraine in the long term. The workshop will also widen knowledge in an academic environment about the state of the research in Ukraine
